## DECEMBER 31

China alerts the W.H.O. of a viral outbreak

## JANUARY 7

New virus identified as COVID-19



## JANUARY 20

First cases of COVID-19 outside of China reported

## JANUARY 30

The W.H.O. declares COVID-19 a global health emergency



## FEBRUARY 21

California AB 3216 (paid sick leave) introduced

## FEBRUARY 29

U.S. reports first COVID-19 death



## MARCH 5

California declares state of emergency due to pandemic

Congress approves \$8.5 billion in emergency funding

## MARCH 11

W.H.O. officially declares COVID-19 a pandemic



## MARCH 13

President Trump declares a national emergency

Police fatally shoot Breonna Taylor in her home at night while she was sleeping\*

## MARCH 16

Stock market drops 13%



## MARCH 18

President Trump signs Congressional Corona relief package

## MARCH 19

CDC reports 40% of hospitalized COVID-19 patients aren't elderly

California issues a stay-at-home order



\* As a reminder, Breonna Taylor's killers are still free

## LATE MARCH - MAY

### WEEK OF MARCH 26

57 new cases of COVID-19 reported in prisons exposing issues within the prison system

Some states attempt to restrict abortion access due to the expectation of the rush of incoming patients

### MARCH 26

--The U.S. confirmed with the most cases in the world

### APRIL 2

10 million Americans have been put out of work

--3.2 million unemployment claims filed

### APRIL 3

U.S. stops funding to the W.H.O.

### APRIL 14

--The U.S. registers the highest daily death toll of any nation so far  
--Global cases pass 1 million  
--CDC recommends Americans wear masks

### APRIL 20

President Trump announces halt of immigration to supposedly stop the spread of COVID-19

### MAY 5

Study from the CDC and KFF finds African Americans at higher risk of contracting COVID-19

### MAY 7

Video released of Ahmaud Arbery killing, 73 days after the incident

### MAY 25

George Floyd dies in police custody

### MAY 26

Millions protest around the world against police brutality and systemic racism following the police killing of George Floyd

## MAY 29

- 100,000 Americans have now died from COVID-19 in 4 months
- U.S. partnership with W.H.O. is terminated

## JUNE 1

Police use unnecessary force against protesters in Lafayette Square

## JUNE 3

The Justice in Policing Act is introduced by Senators Booker and Harris.

## JUNE 4

President Trump's administration rolls back environmental regulations

## JUNE 11

2 million cases of COVID-19 have been confirmed in the U.S.

## JUNE 12

- Rayshard Brooks killed by police
- Minneapolis City Council unanimously votes to replace police department with a community-led public safety system
- President Trump's administration rolls back Obama-era protections against discrimination of transgender people in health care

## JUNE 15

- Supreme Court decides not to hear guns-rights cases or a case against CA's immigrant sanctuary law
- Supreme Court upholds Civil Rights Act of 1964 that protects gay and transgender workers from discrimination
- President Trump's administration proposes regulations to prevent most migrants from claiming political asylum

## JULY 16

Unmarked federal officials in unmarked vehicles begin taking protesters off the streets in Portland without reason
